## How to Revise

It is important that students test themselves as they revise. This will let them know how much information they have retained and what needs 'topping up'. There are lots of ways that students can be tested:

### 1. Look, say, cover, check

This is often how we learn spellings: look at the word; say the word; cover the word; write the word and then check the word you have written.

### 2. Quick quiz

This is where parents can quiz students on the information, using questions in revision guides. Flashcards can help with this as well.

### 3. Do some exam questions

The best way to test knowledge is by answering exam questions and to have them marked by a parent or teacher.
